New location set for tonight's Guardian Angels meeting

LORAIN — A public meeting with the Toledo director of the Guardian Angels safety group will be at 6 p.m. tonight at Fabyan's Restaurant, 401 Broadway, Lorain, a new location.

The meeting is being hosted to discuss safety on Lorain's streets. The location was changed due to increased interest, according to Lorain resident Denise Caruloff, who invited the director of the Toledo chapter of the Guardian Angels, Aaron Brillbeck, to speak on ways to improve safety in Lorain, including foot patrols by pairs of volunteers.

The Guardian Angles were founded in the 1970s to stop crime on New York City streets and subways, and chapters have since been started in cities across the country, including Cleveland, Detroit and Toledo.

Members of Lorain City Council, block watch groups and the general public are invited to attend tonight's meeting. Coffee will be served.
